






Materials required for assembly

- Masking tape
- Square (optional)
- PZ1 & PZ2 screwdriver
- Wood glue (slow-drying recommended)
- Damp cloth (or paper towel)
- Tape measure or ruler (for hinge positioning)
- Pencil (for marking hinges)

Your bed consists of 3 packages:








For the assembly of packages N° 2 and N° 3, in order to facilitate the maintenance of the parts during the different stages, we advise you if possible to have a second person help you.

Nead before assembling the furniture


- · Check for chips in the grooves
- Check that the parts are free of defects before gluing / or make a dry fitting
- Read the entire instructions carefully before final assembly with glue
- Wipe off excess glue with a damp cloth immediately after gluing each piece
- Make any cuts (if necessary) before gluing the furniture
- Protect the surrounding areas of the gluing areas with masking tape to reduce cleaning




PACK N° 1: RIGHT UNIT




PACK N° 2: FRONT LEFT UNIT











PACK N° 3: REAR LEFT UNIT

Screw 45 mm X 8













Apply a sufficient amount of glue to the contact surfaces and grooves. The glue should slightly protrude from the grooves when assembled.

Wipe off excess glue with a damp cloth after assembly.











FRONT PART ASSEMBLY



(1.2) Apply glue to the notches and junctions then assemble part **J** with the I/H assembly.




ig(1.3ig) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part **K** with the rest of the furniture.




RIGHT UNIT ASSEMBLY


(1.4) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble the **L** piece with the rest of the furniture.



ig(1.5ig) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble two **F** angles as below.



Apply glue then assemble part M with the rest of the furniture then screw this part from the inside of the furniture using six 25 mm screws.




(2) REAR PART ASSEMBLY

Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble parts **A** and **B**.

(2.2) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part **C** with the **A/B** assembly.




(2.3) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part **D** with the rest of the furniture.




(2.4) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part **E** with the rest of the furniture.



(2.5) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble two **F** angles as below.



2.6 Apply glue then assemble part G with the rest of the furniture then screw this part from the inside of the furniture using six 25 mm screws.




ASSEMBLY PACK N°2 LEFT UNIT / FRONT Part




For the assembly of **packages N° 2** and **N° 3**, in order to facilitate the maintenance of the parts during the different stages, **we advise you if possible to have a second person help you.**


Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble the two slats **D1** and the two slats **D2** with part **A**.



igg(2igg) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part **C** with the rest of the bed base.




3 Apply glue, then assemble and screw part **F** to part **E** using six 25 mm screws. **Ensure parts F and E are properly aligned.**





ASSEMBLY FRONT LEFT UNIT

 $oldsymbol{4}$ Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble parts **G** and **B**.




Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble the E/F assembly with the rest of the bed base.






 $\overline{7}$ Apply glue to the notches and joints then glue part **I** to part **E**.



 $ig(oldsymbol{8} ig)$ Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part **J** with the rest of the furniture.




 $oldsymbol{(9)}$ Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part **K** with the rest of the furniture.



ASSEMBLY PACK N°3 LEFT UNIT / REAR Part




To assemble this final package, in order to facilitate the maintenance of the parts during the different stages, we advise you, if possible, to have a second person help you.


igg(1) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble the three D1 slats and the two D2 slats with part A.




ig(2) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble part ${f c}$ with the rest of the bed base.




 $\stackrel{\frown}{3}$ Apply glue then assemble the two angles **E** on part **F**.







(7) Apply glue to the notches and glue part **J** to part **H**.




(8) Apply glue to the notches and joints then assemble the **F/E** assembly with the rest of the furniture.




Apply glue to the notches and joints then glue part **K** to the rest of the furniture.




(10) Apply glue to the notches and assemble the **L** piece with the rest of the furniture.




Apply glue to the joints and assemble parts **M** and **O**, then **screw them together** using three 25 mm screws.



12 Apply glue to the notches and joints, then the entire M/O assembly with the rest of the furniture.



 $\stackrel{\textstyle \bullet}{13}$ Apply glue to the notches and joints and assemble the four angles **N** as below.



DOORS ASSEMBLY




1 Door assembly philosophy


- 2 hinges per door
- Position the hinges along the longest length opposite the push-lock button location.
- Before screwing the push-lock and the hinges, make sure to screw it on the correct side of the front, respecting the

Pushlock Assembly


Force the push lock rosette onto the visible side of the front (check the direction of the wood).



Screw the button onto the push lock.




Screw the push lock in place with two 12mm screws. Make sure it is aligned with the top of the door.



ASSEMBLY OF DOORS, HINGES, PUSH LOCKS & STOPS

(2) Assembly of hinges


(2.1) Position the hinge 5 cm from the edge of the door and fold the hinge onto the FRONT of the door.



(2.2) Screw the hinges using the 12 mm screws.




Position the door in its frame and center it, then fold the hinge down onto the front of the furniture and make a slight mark using a pencil or tape.




ASSEMBLY OF DOORS, HINGES, PUSH LOCKS & STOPS

Align one hinge with the front of the cabinet and fold it down over the front of the cabinet to match the previously marked hole. Then screw in a 12mm screw (hole in the middle of the hinge). Unscrew the hinge and repeat this process to mark the hole for the second hinge, then unscrew the hinge.




With the door fitted with its screwed hinges, screw the hinges onto the furniture using the 12 mm screws, using the reference holes made in the previous step.




(3) Mounting the stops

Close and lock the doors then **screw the 5mm latches inside the cabinet** as shown below with 12mm screws. **Note that only door M1 does not have a latch.**
